Alternators and Transformers. He discussed about the current transformers, potential transformers, isolators and software's used for relay coordination. ■

There was an entertainment session that followed. Soothing music filled the auditorium as talented singers stepped up the stage. The evening concluded with refreshments. ■



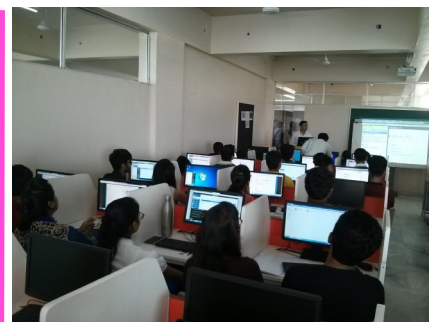
IMEA: Seminar on Awareness about Post Graduation in Foreign Universities
