

IDEA: Expert Lecture by Ar Peter Rich & Prof. Miki Desai



Ar Peter Rich is the founder partner of Light Earth Designs LLP. His distinctive body of work is testament to a lifetime commitment to the creation of a unique African

Prof. Miki Desai delivered an expert lecture on Tectonics in Architecture. He elaborated on articulation & its progression from



primitive to an evolved traditional architecture. The session ended with an interactive session with students and faculty.

Contour Survey Project by Civil Department



The students of Indus University, Civil Engineering 4th Semester were assigned to perform a Contour Survey of a place in the city called Hathijan. The contour survey is mainly used to determine the water storage capacity of reservoir, Road & Railway alignment. On 20th March'17 the team arrived at Hathijan for the field work. Prof. Amit Singh divided students in groups and distributed the instruments to each group. The

method by which contour survey was to be performed was Radiation Method. The Benchmark was set as 100m. A center point was marked as a reference point and was considered station origin. Five different station points were taken covering the area as per five groups. Readings were taken from the station point at 30 degree interval. Staff readings were recorded at every 2 meters from the station up to at least 60 meters of distance. The distance between the station points were measured using and instrument called the Total Station. Further the internal Angles, Fore Bearing, Back Bearing and Magnetic Meridian were found. The readings were noted down and a diagram was drawn. The field work began at 8:30AM and ended by 5:00PM. Teams were overjoyed to see their work being paid off well on accurate readings. This field work helped students gain practical knowledge with organizational behavioral traits such as leadership and team Work
